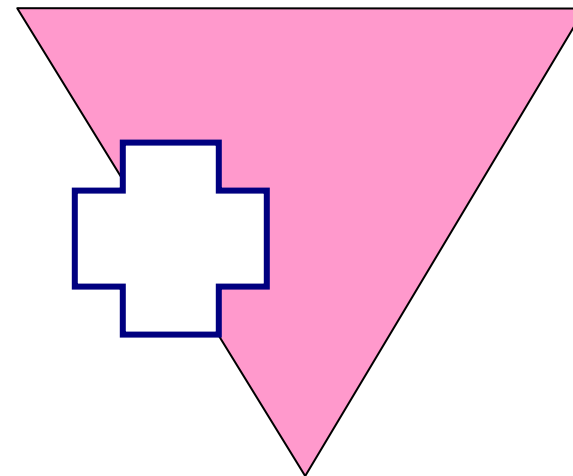

LUKE 24: 13-35 tells us that two of Jesus' disciples met Him on the road to the village of Emmaus. The encounter renewed their hopes and sense of mission. Gay and lesbian Catholics continue to meet Jesus as they journey to the Kingdom. The Emmaus retreat is a time to encounter Christ and to share the journey together.

The Emmaus retreat will be facilitated by Brother Denis Weber, S.J. and Sister Marian Durkin, CSA.

Denis Weber, S.J. is a member of the Society of Jesus. He earned his Masters in Spirituality from Duquesne University and currently serves as pastoral minister at and liturgist at Gesu Parish in University Heights, Ohio.

Marian Durkin, C.S.A., one of the founders of the Emmaus Retreat, is a member of the Sisters of Charity of St. Augustine and is enjoying semi-retirement.

Michael Tueth, SJ will be a guest presenter on Saturday, October 9th.

Michael Tueth teaches situational comedy and religion and media at the Lincoln Center at Fordham University. He also ministers to the pastoral needs of students.

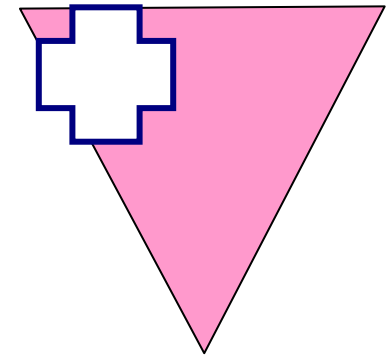
